It was in July that his shunts were put in. As soon as we returned home, the battle of the infection began. He saw the doctor on Thursday, and we got the results from the swab today. He has MRSA. The tubes must be removed ASAP. Ms. Cheryl has been working on communicating with the hospital in Istanbul and buying tickets. Ruslan and I will fly early Monday morning. We will arrive at 09:00 Istanbul time and be picked up by the hospital. At this time, we don't know what the cost will be. I do know that God already sent two gifts for travel expenses that will cover the flight. We still have funds for the medical from the last trip. None of this has taken God by surprise.

We don't know what all God is doing nor why. If we never fully understand, it will be alright. I learned a long time ago that when you cannot see His hand, you can still trust His heart.

We need Ruslan to keep his strength. I will be going alone with him. We desperately need God to keep this infection under control. It could turn into meningitis.
