The topography shows that the shunts are working fine and did not reveal any trouble. The spinal tap shows no sign of infection. The rest of the spinal tap test will be ready in 5 days.

I spoke with his doctor, and he does not believe that there is an infection in the shunt system.

We will do another MRI this evening to see if the tumors have grown and what else we may understand.

At least one more night in the hospital then, if nothing changes, we will need an apartment or hotel.

Ruslan's last fever was Sunday. There was an infection on and around the shunt system last week. We have the test results. We will keep him on the antibiotic for at least 10 days. God is doing a mighty work. Please don't miss it. Give God the praise due and continue to pray for Ruslan.

Ms. Cheryl is doing better, too. The headache is gone, but she still has a cough, no fever. Thank you for praying for her.
