

The Meyer Family Missionaries to Spain



Greetings Pastors, supporting Churches and friends,

What an incredible summer we had this year! First, we were able to take 16 people to the summer camp we attend every year in Belgium. Most of the group went by plane but I drove the church van with the other group. It's about an 18 hour drive to get there. The group that flew, landed in Luxemburg and took the train to the camp, which is located in the Ardenne forest near the German border. Camp was extra special this year as we saw many decisions made for God's glory and saw several teenagers saved during the 10 days of camp. Many in our group didn't have the money to go to camp but I encouraged them to have faith, sign up anyway and pray! Well they all signed up and thanks to our Supporting Churches we had all the funds to take everyone to camp and pay for the transportation! It truly was a life changing experience for our group and we are so very thankful God allowed us all to go.

When we got back to Spain, we geared up for our very first Vacation Bible School. Those who had been helped to go to camp agreed to a summer work program, so they all volunteered to help us with vacation Bible School and WOW! It went really well! We had lots of first time visitors including a friend of my daughter from our neighbourhood whose parents we have been witnessing to for years, well she came on day one and loved it and came every day and even had her atheist dad helping her memorize Bible verses! VBS was a great time for growth in our church and seeing everyone working together was wonderful.

At the end of August we said goodbye to our oldest daughter Hadassah who went off to Bible College. While we are excited for her, we can't help but feel a big hole in both our family and ministry. It has definitely been an adjustment but we look forward to having her home for Christmas for a month.

Also during the summer we paused our Bible Seminary and instead did a big discipleship with new believers and newer attendees to our Church. I taught the men and Claudia taught the ladies. Its an 8 week course and at the end we were able to add 16 new members to our Church. This also fell right into our annual Church retreat which we do at a campground about an hour outside of Madrid, next to a river, and there I was able to baptise the believers that hadn't been baptised yet.

We have started to have 2 services in the morning now in order to fit everyone into our building until we are able to find a bigger place. So far we haven't found anything, but having 2 services has worked really well! There are now over 100 people who regularly attend our services and with this set up we have room for everyone, a place for moms and babies to go to and also allows us to have a junior Church which we just started.

It was my joy to welcome another young baby into our Church family a few days ago! One of our deacons, Geovanny, and his wife Edith gave birth to a son they named Mark. Its such a blessing to see external and internal growth in the Church and recently to see many more children in our Sunday school program!
