Hello, brothers and sisters, I hope you are well. May God bless you.

I am writing this letter solely to you, who have been part of our ministry for so many years with monthly support and prayers. We know we hold a place in your hearts and in your churches, just as you hold that place in our hearts and ministry. I don't want to share it with the entire GPA group at this time, although I appreciate everyone's prayers and know that God has also blessed us with the love of many brothers and sisters. I want to share these needs with you so that you may pray with greater wisdom and understanding for my family and ministry.

- Please pray for our monthly support. We're working to grow the work here, however, the process has been very slow. The same happens with delegation tours. God has been faithful, and we've never lacked anything we need. However, sometimes the situation gets complicated with unexpected things that arise, and the savings we try to save aren't enough. That's why I'm planning a deputation tour in October to raise \$750, which would be enough to accommodate me with my things and move freely around the ministry and family matters. Since we live in the countryside, things come up for which we have to travel to San José. The specific prayer is that I can raise that \$750.

- Another request is for our car, a 2001 Toyota Corolla. It's very good, but a bit old... last Friday the radiator burst, and I had to get it fixed in an emergency and take out a \$360 loan for basic repairs. However, the mechanic told me I need to make other repairs that cost \$700, which totals \$1,060. The specific request is for \$1,060 to fix this and for God to provide me with a more comfortable and slightly more modern SUV. To give you an idea, a 2006 Toyota RAV 4, 7-passenger model, or a Hyundai, costs around \$12,000, and right now it would be impossible to finance one. (Actually, keeping the Corolla would be a blessing since we need a second car.)

- Please pray, brothers, for glasses for my daughter, Flory, and me, which cost around \$480 in total. We have been praying for this for several months.

- Finally, brothers and sisters, please pray for a job for Samuel. He is in the middle of his Computer Security Engineering Degree, has a B2 level of English, and has related training. He needs a job and is applying to several companies. Please help us pray for this.

Brothers and sisters, I don't want to burden you with this; however, I felt it in my heart to share these needs with you, knowing that you are people of prayer.

We continue to work with joy and purpose for the Lord in the place He established us to be a light and carry His Word. We are also praying to expand to another place.

May God bless you richly.
