We are excited to share about our recent and upcoming ministry opportunities! — In **January and February of 2025**, our family had the wonderful privilege of taking a survey trip to **Peru**. We served alongside Brother **Joe Kotvas** of (MWBM) and **Efata** (Efata.org) in **three Deaf church plants** around **Lima**: Villa El Salvador, Callao, and Chosica.

During our time in Peru, we fully immersed ourselves in the local culture and Deaf community. We dedicated ourselves to learning the spoken language, Spanish, and Peruvian Sign Language. We had many opportunities to serve, including participating in church services, engaging in Deaf outreach, ministering to children and youth, working on building projects, serving in Deaf/Blind ministry, sharing through music and preaching, and distributing Spanish Gospel tracts wherever we went. We have a deep love for serving in international ministry, as well as reaching the Deaf with the Gospel here in the United States. We praise God for continually opening doors for more international ministry, and we eagerly look forward to future opportunities to serve both at home and abroad! Throughout our travels, we were also able to connect with and invest time in training several young Deaf and hearing individuals who are interested in pursuing missions work with the Deaf. We are so grateful for the blessed opportunity to invest in the next generation of servants, missionaries, and preachers!





In February, I joined **Brother David Bennett**, the International Director of Silent Word Ministries, for a two-week survey trip to Tokyo, Japan. This **November 2025**, **SWMI** will be taking a mission team to **Japan** for the **100th Anniversary of the Deaflympics**. Together, Brother Bennett and I made plans and arrangements for accommodations, transportation, and a detailed itinerary focused on sharing the Gospel in and around the various venues hosting the Olympic sporting events. This significant international event is expected to draw approximately **3,000 Deaf athletes**. In addition to the athletes, the Deaflympics is anticipated to have over **15,000 attendees**, including essential support

personnel, parents, siblings, relatives, friends, and spectators. We are currently recruiting a team of up to **24 people** to join us in witnessing and sharing the love of Jesus at this event. We plan to use Gospel tracts and various sign languages to reach Deaf individuals from all around the world with the Good News!


Our family is planning to be a part of this Deaflympics mission team.
