Thank you for praying for Andrew's school situation. We have been trying for several months now to get an assistant in the classroom with Andrew. I was able to meet with the head of the education department in Nagykanizsa yesterday, and Ferenc was very helpful. Our friend, Szilárd, had talked with him previously about our situation, and he was already thinking about it, which was a great advantage. We were able to get the original lady who helped Andrew for the first two weeks of the school year. She was just doing an internship for the first week, and she donated her week off the following week in order to stay and help him. We are very thankful for that, and that Andrew can work with her again. She did a fantastic job with him.

I also heard from our real estate agent this week about our apartment in Nyíregyháza. There is a prospective buyer who is trying to choose right now between our house and another property. We appreciate your prayers for this.

Thank you for praying as well for the prospective high school outreach. I will be speaking with the principal of the school next Monday, Lord-willing, about volunteering at the school with English, which will be the first step. We can then use that contact to invite the young people to an after-school program, Bible studies, etc. There is an openness right now with youth, not just in America, but here in Europe as well, as nihilism has run its course in a lot of ways and people are looking for worth, value and something to believe in.

As part of our involvement with the Special Olympics movement here in Hungary, we will be starting up a young athletes (1-12 year olds) program here in Nagykanizsa. I am in the process of trying to locate parents who would be interested in something like this. It will be great opportunity to offer spiritual help to the families of these children as well.

Sarah has had some good opportunities with the ladies here in our group of believers. She would appreciate your prayers as she plans a ladies' Bible study that will meet on a regular basis.

This past Sunday, we ministered in Budapest at Életvíz Baptist Church. The people seem to be very responsive, and it appears that God is beginning a deep work in that group of believers. We always appreciate the time we can spend with them.

A group of independent Baptist missionary friends of ours in Ireland has been putting together a dramatic film about the life of Patrick which will be used as an evangelistic tool throughout that country. I have had the privilege of ministering in music and preaching in Ireland here and there over the years, and I am currently helping them with the soundtrack for this film. Please pray for this endeavor as well. I believe the Lord is in it, and will use it in a powerful way in the coming years.
