The following is a summary of our ministry in Guanacaste:

By God's marvelous grace, we are faithfully serving the Lord.

Our ministry of church activity involves the following events:

- We emphasize the need to pray for one another, not only in church but also through prayer meetings in the homes.
- We prioritize the sharing of the gospel with others.
- We regularly visit the brethren in their homes to pray with them and encourage them to be faithful in their walk with the Lord.
- We visit those who are ill, both in their homes and in the hospital in order to comfort them in their afflictions and to encourage them in the Lord and his word.
