This is Janet's daughter Jeanine again with another health update on my mom. Today marks three weeks that my mom has been in a nearby rehab facility, where the therapists are working diligently to help her get her strength back after the heart episode that sent her to the hospital back in October. Thankfully, her heart has stayed stable during these weeks in the rehab center, and a visit last week to the cardiologist confirmed that. She has progressed to the point that she is able to ambulate with her walker to where she needs to go in her room and then also to the therapy room. She has had a couple of setbacks from time to time (mainly because of her Parkinsons and an infection) and has not been given a discharge date yet. At this point, it looks like she will be in the facility for at least another 3 weeks. She has been a trooper as she works through therapy, often twice a day, which leaves her exhausted. But she wants to get stronger and is also thankful for opportunities to pass out Gospel calendars to all the different people that help with her care.

Thank you so much for caring and praying for my mom. She needs strength to continue fighting her way back to better health, and we all need guidance concerning her future care.
