Ana Chacon has been a missionary since before we arrived on the field in May of 1980. Her specialty was in Child Evangelism. After his salvation, her husband, Bro. Nisbel Chacon was called into Missionary Evangelism and eventually came with the GPA where he had the ministry of building local churches and reaching the lost not only in Costa Rica, but later in the US and several other Latin countries. Ana worked alongside him in the field of Children's Ministry and holding workshops for Teacher Training in those national churches where her husband carried out his ministry. After her husband's passing several years ago, Ana has continued serving the Lord with the GPA, both in reaching and teaching children for Christ in local-church Sunday School and VBS ministries, along with carrying out Teacher-training courses in Costa Rica and other parts of the US. Her other countries of service have been Mexico, Puerto Rico, and Honduras, and she will continue to visit these places as the Lord leads through the invitations of the national local churches.

Just recently, Ana was diagnosed with colon cancer and is awaiting surgery. meanwhile she remains faithful in her ministry. In fact, she and another colleague now have a new on-line ministry of prayer and edification of Christian ladies. Since I have had the privilege of knowing and working with Ana, as far back as our early days in Costa Rica, she has gone out of her way to be a hospitable and selfless host (washed the saints' feet) to many servants of God. She is worthy of our prayers and financial help.

I say that because December's missionary support for Ana was a mere \$115. With a normal average of only \$400-\$500 monthly support, she constantly struggles to get by while living with her daughter Grettel and her autistic son, Leo. Together, they can make mortgage payments. Today, she was forced to withdraw from her travel fund \$400 to pay priority bills. Without having to continue to stress the importance of her life and ministry, I think that she deserves some help from her few supporting churches and those who know and appreciate her life's service for the Lord.
