John 1:14 And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.

The greatest miracle of the ages is described in Luke 2:11: For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Saviour, which is Christ the Lord. The first chapter of the book of John, does not depict Jesus Christ as a baby, but as the WORD of God and His desire to save mankind.
