Dear Brethren,

I am writing on behalf of veteran missionary Ana Chacon, widow of the late Nisbel Chacon, long-time pastor and missionary evangelist with the GPA. Ana has been in missions, working in child evangelism and Sunday School ministry even before her husband entered into fulltime evangelism work in the early 1980s in Costa Rica.

As a widow, it has been difficult for Ana to maintain monthly support, even though she remains faithful to the work God placed her in many years ago, even before she worked alongside her husband, both in Costa Rica and the US, not to mention various other countries traveling with missionary evangelist Chacon. So, when mortgage payments are due and bills have to be paid, she totally depends upon the Lord and his promises to keep her afloat.

Ana was recently diagnosed with having colon cancer and is currently undergoing chemo treatments. The doctors have advised her to avoid getting out into cold weather and being in chilly environments. Here in Florida, even though the weather is sub-tropical, at times the temperature dips, even in to the 20s and 30s, like at this very moment when the forecasters are predicting the temperatures to drop to below thirty in the next couple of days.

Two days ago, I received a call from Ana, learning that her air conditioner and heating units weren't working. I later spoke with an Hispanic friend from her church who was a technician and was familiar with Ana's situation. From talking to Ana, I had gotten the idea that the problem was something simple and not too expensive to repair. I was given another story from the technician friend. The entire unit needed to be replaced. Regular companies could charge between \$6000 and \$8000 for a new unit. The technician, whom I've known for many years, wanted to help Ana as much as he could, him being a long-time friend and faithful Christian servant in their local church. He said he could get a unit and replace the old one for as low as \$4000, without charging Ana for the labor. To make a long story short, Ana needs \$4000 urgently.

I know that God, who is gracious and merciful, can supply that important need for his servant Ana.

Would you please pray and maybe consider helping her in this time of great need? God works through his servants as channels of blessing.

If you would like to help, you can go to the gpamissions.com website, click on MENU, then look for OUR MISSIONARY FAMILY, then click on that. Scroll down through the families, until you come to Ana Chacon. Then click on DONATE TO ANA CHACON.

You will receive instructions on how to donate. It's as simple as that, and the money can be accessed as soon as it is deposited directly into her account. You will be given credit for your donation just as if you had sent a check into the mission office by way of regular postal mail. This technology saves much time and possible hang-ups (even lost checks) when using the snail-mail method.
