Colossians 3:2 Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth.

I read a story about Ewan McAllister. Ewan is a conservation officer with the “Canadian Wildlife Service”. The story stated that he stared in amazement at the site before his eyes. A group of canoers had interrupted their journey down the Teslin River of Yukon Territory and were taking a lunch break. The tantalizing smell of grilling hamburgers and onions drifted through the surrounding evergreen forest. The pleasant aroma stirred the canoers’ appetites, but unfortunately, it would also stimulate the appetites of the grizzly bears that are abundant in this wilderness area.

Officer McAllister quickly informed the travelers of the extremely dangerous situation that their cookout had placed them in. He strongly urges them to immediately move downriver, but his warning resulted only in disbelief and a refusal to budge. Threatened with immediate arrest, however, the group grudgingly paddle away.

The Bible is complete with warnings that bring blessings if heeded but dire consequences when ignored. Deuteronomy 8:11 says, “Beware that thou forget not the LORD thy God, in not keeping his commandments, and his judgments, and his statutes, which I command thee this day.” That scripture applies no less to us today than it did to the Hebrews thousands of years ago. False prophets, evil companions, covetousness, hypocrisy, lying teachers, sensuous women, the love of money, and the praise of men are only a few of the deadly snares that the Bible urges us to be aware of.
