Ministry Events

In early March, we held our annual Evangelistic Conference on a Friday through Sunday. I will be honest; I was pretty nervous when, on the first night of the conference, we only had about 40 people present and no visitors. However, God blessed in a great way. The next night, we had a full house, and Sunday night was even more packed, with well over 100 people in attendance. We thank the Lord for the souls that were saved during the conference and for the excitement it gave our people.

At the end of March, I was honored to be able to preach a Prayer Conference for a pastor friend about 45 minutes away. God blessed, attendance was strong, and the altars were full each night of the conference.

This past weekend was a special Easter service and the start of our Fall Program. We were completely full again, with several first-time visitors, and we had hands raised for salvation at the end of the service. One of those was a man who was hired onto our construction work crew. He has been working with us for several weeks, but it wasn't until this weekend that he finally came.

Construction Update

Due to the ongoing bureaucratic process to get all the building and permit documentation squared away (at a glacial-drift pace, might I add), we have not yet started the building of our new auditorium at the new church property. This isn't necessarily a bad thing, as it allows us more time to raise the needed funds to cover the construction costs. We have taken the opportunity during this interlude to take care of some updates and remodeling of the existing structure at the property so that it will better suit our church's needs.
