Dear Brethren,

A church in Mercerville, Ohio had promised to take up an offering this past Sunday morning for the cancer surgery of Zilenia Corrales, wife of Missionary Luis Corrales in Quibor, Venezuela. The total cost of the surgery was \$7,200. We were blessed to receive a donation of \$2000 from our church here in Florida, leaving a balance of \$5,200 needed to fund the operation, which had been delayed until August 15. The original date for the procedure was as early as July 30, but the doctor wanted to take further pictures of the nodule in her left lung, and so decided to extend the date to August 15. We were relieved, since this gave us more time to promote the amount of money needed for the surgery. However, as the doctor said, the operation had to be done as soon as possible to prevent the cancer from spreading.

I received a message from the pastor on Sunday afternoon, asking that I give him a call. When he answered, he said, "Brother, we did not get the \$5200, but we did get \$6500. **GLORY TO GOD!! HOW GRACIOUS AND MERCIFUL IS OUR GOD!!**

Another blessing came on the heels of this one. Missionary Alex Araya contacted me and asked if I could come to Costa Rica to translate for a couple of visiting US pastors – Pastor David Goforth of South Carolina and his brother Mike Goforth from Michigan. I had been Pastor David's interpreter on several past trips to Costa Rica when he was pastor for ten years at Providence Baptist, our church here in Riverview, FL. Needless to say, Bro. Goforth is well acquainted with Bro. Araya's ministry. It was to be a three-day meeting from August 7-9. I explained to Alex that I wasn't in a position to pay the \$800-\$1000 airfare just to make a quick trip to Costa Rica and back. But I learned that it was the fellowship of being together for those three days that was so important to Alex. I have known and worked alongside Bro. Alex

I replied, "Yes, I will be interpreting the meetings." He then asked, "How much do you need for the trip?" I stammered around and said, "Well, the price is quite expensive – anywhere from \$800-\$1000. "Do you need more?" He was insistent, and he let me know that it was no problem for him. So, I said, "Probably a little extra for expenses." With a smile on his face, he wrote me a check for \$1500 and then said, "Say hello to my good friend Pastor Goforth."

What can I say? When I shared this with Alex, he responded by saying **"GLORY TO GOD!! THIS IS OF GOD!!"** (In Spanish, of course)
