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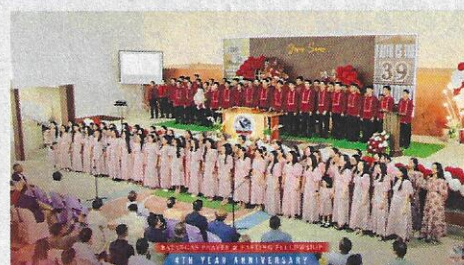
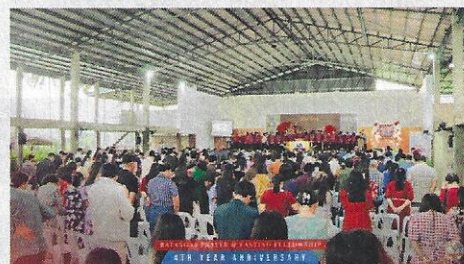
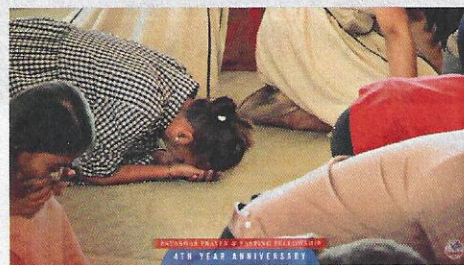
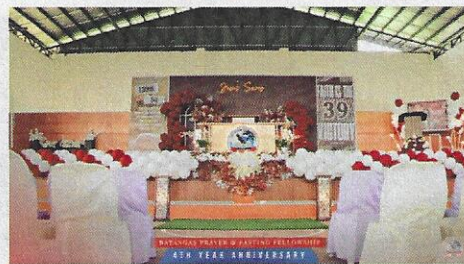
Ministry Update January & February Rejoicing in What the Lord Has Done

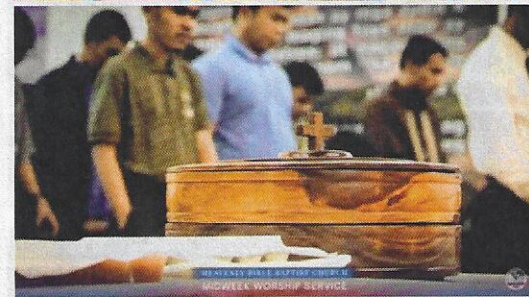
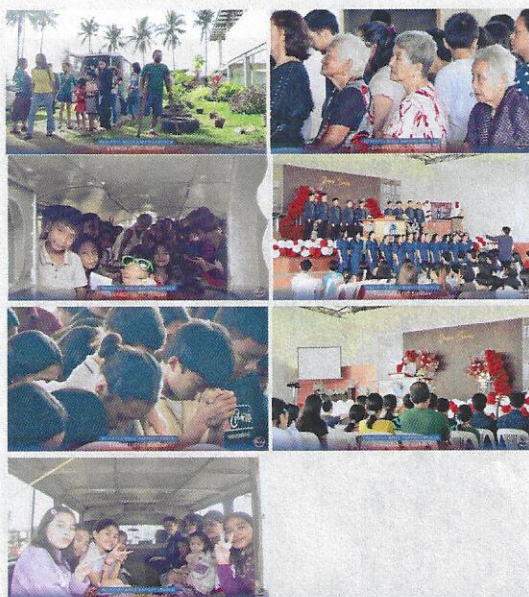




On January 22, we conducted our Review & Reflection Meeting for our Good News Ministry teachers. We prepared dinner for them as a small token of appreciation. Preacher Jayjay shared an encouraging message, and together we reflected on the past year, reviewing updates and prayerfully discussing areas for growth and improvement.

On January 25, we held our first Evangelistic Sunday of the year with the theme "May Pag-asa sa Pamamagitan ni Kristo." The Lord impressed upon our hearts to dedicate the last Sunday of each month to evangelism. It was a special day where members intentionally invited their family and friends to hear the Gospel. Though preparing meals for all visitors and fetching and bringing them to their homes is a great commitment, we are reminded that we serve a God who provides—and He did.

We also launched our Goodwill Ministry this January. Through this effort, items are shared and given, and the proceeds are dedicated to supporting the Mangyan Ministry in Mindoro. The Mangyan people are indigenous tribes who often live in remote mountainous areas, relying on farming, handicrafts, and simple livelihoods. Many have limited access to education and resources, making ministry support



both vital and meaningful. It is our prayer that through this outreach, we may help meet both their physical and spiritual needs.

In addition, we continued observing the Lord's Supper every first Wednesday of the month, holding Prayer Vigils every second Friday, and conducting Preacher Men Training every last Friday from 8:00 PM to midnight. Our daily morning devotions via Google Meet at 5:30 AM also remain strong, as we begin each day anchored in God's Word.

February Highlights

On February 1, we resumed our Discipleship Classes after a brief pause due to the many activities in January. We thank the Lord for the eagerness of those who continue to grow in their faith and knowledge of Him.

On February 22, we held our second Evangelistic Sunday with the theme "Bukas ang Puso ng Dios para sa'yo." Our choir presented a powerful drama portraying a man trapped in a cycle of sin and generational struggles, who ultimately finds freedom in Christ. The message was clear and impactful—the door is open in Jesus. We praise the Lord for 210 visitors (adults and children) who attended that day and heard the Gospel.



After the morning service, we also celebrated the birthday of Preacher Jayjay, my only son. The church lovingly prepared different kinds of food for everyone to enjoy, making it a time of joyful fellowship. I am deeply thankful to the Lord for my son's life—how he has chosen to follow the path of surrender and serve God in the ministry.
